Volunteers donated **17,334 hours** of time and talent to support Pillars throughout **4,584 shifts**.



Pillars Adult Shelter provided **19,354 nights of sleep** and Pillars Adult and Family Shelter provided **26,713 nights of sleep**.

The Pillars Winter Shelter Overflow Program sheltered an additional **64 adults and 69 children**.

Pillars owns and operates **140 units** across **40 properties**, providing our community with safe, cost-accessible housing.



Pillars served 1,909 people in 2023.
