Volunteers donated **more than 16,000 hours** of time and talent to support Pillars. That's **worth approximately \$550,000!**



Pillars Adult Shelter provided **18,331 nights of sleep** and Pillars Adult & Family Shelter provided **26,323 nights of sleep**.

The Pillars Cold Weather Program sheltered an additional **163 clients** while they waited to enter a shelter.

Pillars owns and operates **152 units** across **48 properties**, providing our community with safe, cost-accessible housing.



Pillars served 1,740 people in 2025.
