Pillars Adult Shelter provided
18,847 nights of sleep and
Pillars Adult and Family
Shelter provided 27,113
nights of sleep.

The Pillars Winter Shelter
Overflow Program sheltered
an additional **114 adults and 49 children** while they
waited to enter a shelter.

Pillars owns and operates 132 units across 38 properties, providing our community with safe, cost-accessible housing.



Pillars served about 1,800 people in 2024.
